

TEMPORARY Licensure

in Iowa

for ASL Interpreters

REQUIREMENTS

ONE of the following

- The written portion of the RID, BEI, or the EIPA examination,
- The **EIPA prehire examination** at the highest recommended level,
- An associate degree or higher from a formal interpreter training program (ITP) with a regionally accredited college with an official transcript verifying completion
- ASLPI at the 2+ level or higher,
- **SLPI** at the intermediate level or higher.

2 YEAR CYCLE

CAN RENEW ONE TIME

Mentoring Requirement

- Mentor must have a permanent license in good standing in Iowa.
- Temporary licensee must submit a SUPERVISORY AGREEMENT with their application for a license.
- SUPERVISORY AGREEMENT must include licensee and mentor:
 - Names, Address, Contact information, and signatures

Continuing Education Requirement

• Licensee must earn **40 hours** of continuing education during each licensure cycle. **(4.0 CEUs)**
