## REQUIREMENTS

**\$120**

### ONE of the following

- The **written portion** of the RID, BEI, or the EIPA examination,
- The **EIPA prehire examination** at the highest recommended level,
- An **associate degree or higher** from a formal interpreter training program (ITP) with a regionally accredited college with an official transcript verifying completion
- **ASLPI** at the 2+ level or higher,
- **SLPI** at the intermediate level or higher.

**2 YEAR CYCLE**

**CAN RENEW  
ONE TIME**

### Mentoring Requirement

- Mentor must have a permanent license in good standing in Iowa.
- Temporary licensee must submit a SUPERVISORY AGREEMENT with their application for a license.
- **SUPERVISORY AGREEMENT** must include licensee and mentor:
  - **Names, Address, Contact information, and signatures**

### Continuing Education Requirement

- Licensee must earn **40 hours** of continuing education during each licensure cycle. **(4.0 CEUs)**
